
## Mounting C. elegans for Imaging

## **Reagents Needed:**

1mM Levamisole (optional)

## **Procedure:**

- 1. Prepare boiling 3% agarose in dH<sub>2</sub>0; keep warm on a heating plate.
- 2. Make 2 'depth regulators" by putting lab tape 2-layers deep, length-wise on glass slide.
- 3. Place a blank glass slide between the 'depth regulators'.
- 4. Add a couple drops of warm 3% agarose and cover quickly with a second blank slide at 90 degrees to the first such that this slide rests across the 'depth regulators'.
- 5. Let sit for 1-3 minutes then slide depth regulators out and slide apart the two slides sandwiching the agarose pad.
- 6. If desired, add one drop of 1mM Levamisole onto pad to paralyze the worms.
- 7. Add worms.
- 8. Gently place a glass coverslip on the worms to press them down into the agarose.
- 9. Image away. . .
